4. What parenting model and ministry motivation do you see in this chapter of David's story?
5. What can you do to become a "David" to some "Solomon" whom God has chosen to receive blessings through you? How are you investing in the next generation?
6. Concluding this series of messages on David's life, what most stood out to you? How was he a leader worth following? What does that mean for your own life in these days?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind today?

Prayer: Lord, thank you for the example of David in Scripture and the legacy that he left. Help us also to invest in the next generation and to leave our hopes and dreams in your hands. May we be men and women who are known for following after the heart of God and being leaders worth following. Amen.
